Alert Emergency Equipment Group is requesting approval of a new vehicle dealer license. Their application to request Township approval was motioned by Trustee Platte and seconded by Treasurer Simon and carried.

Supervisor Lakin noted the Chip/Seal for Still Meadows would be the subdivisions responsibility. Mr. Remboski also inquired about the Chip/Seal coverage for his subdivision and will be contacting the County.

Trustee Platte motioned to pay the bills as presented by Clerk Keilen seconded by Supervisor Lakin and carried.
