Supervisor Tiemann motioned to authorize the grant agreement for the Electronic Poll Book laptop and accessories purchase with the Michigan Department of State seconded by Treasurer Simon and carried.

Trustee Platte motioned to authorize the gravel agreement with the Ionia County Road Commission for the year 2010 seconded by Trustee Pung and carried.

Samples of a draft Liquor Ordinance were given to all board members to review and discuss at the May meeting.

The extension of the Assessor's contract and the reappraisal of the Township will be addressed at the May board meeting.
